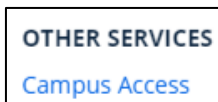

How do I login?

- Go to Statista via the Library portal, or go directly to [Statista.com](https://www.statista.com)
- From the top right corner, select 'login'



- Next, select 'Campus Access'



- Scroll to 'If you have access' – 'Off Campus', then select 'Arden University' and click 'Check access'

Off Campus

If you want to have access to Statista off campus, from home, or a cafe, you can use Shibboleth Access or EZ Proxy. Check if your campus has Shibboleth Access:

Finding Statistics

- Use simple search terms to search for statistics:

For example, if your research question is “To what extent has climate change impacted the UK” A Statista search might look like: ‘*Climate change UK*’ .



- From the search results page:

To view a single statistic, look for results with the blue graph icon:



To view a collection of information, look for results with a red or orange folder icon:



Top tips:



Integrating statistics into your writing is just as important as being able to find them. An Academic Skills Tutor (AST) can help with this!
